## PAINT THE TOWN AGREEMENT

- Artist must be at least 18 years of age.
- Space is limited, pre-registration required for the competition, quick draw and seminar.
- The competition is held rain or shine.
- Media: anything conducive to painting *en plein air* including (but not limited to) oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, gouache and charcoal on varied surfaces.
- Surfaces will be stamped on the back at registration, submitted works must bear the stamp and artist registration number.
- Painting locations must be within the Alpharetta City limits.
- No busking permitted. Sales of pieces completed during Paint the Town should be processed through Arts Alpharetta on May 21st either at the Alpharetta Arts Center or the Wet Paint Sale at the Alpharetta Farmers Market where a 7.75% sales tax will be applied and artist will be given a 70% commission (Arts Alpharetta will retain a 30% commission).
- Artists must be self-contained and ready to paint with their own materials, including but not limited to easels, paints, brushes, water, and surfaces.
- Solvents must be disposed of properly, there is a dumpster located at Alpharetta Arts Center. Do not pour solvents in the trash, on the ground or anywhere that could cause damage to property.
- There are no sinks available for use.
- Artists must not leave any trace of his/her presence at the chosen painting location.
- Artists will NOT enter private property without permission.
- The boat dock and Amorance require the use of a drop cloth.
- You hereby give the City of Alpharetta ("City") permission to take photographs of you you're your artwork) or photographs in which you may be involved with others without compensation to you. These photographs may be used by the City for promotional and informational purposes in print, on the City website and in other media.
