



FOR ARTISTS: PAINT THE TOWN 2023: 5-day Plein Air Artist Invitational

Arts Alpharetta is hosting the 3rd annual *plein air* painting event, Paint the Town, in partnership with the City of Alpharetta and the Alpharetta Convention and Visitors Bureau from Tuesday – Saturday, May 9-13, 2023.

- Artists must be at least 18 years of age.
- Space limited, pre-registration required for the competition.
- The competition is held rain or shine.
- Media: anything conducive to painting *en plein air* including (but not limited to) oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, gouache and charcoal on varied surfaces.
- Surfaces will be stamped on the back at registration, submitted works must bear the stamp and artist registration number.

CATEGORIES - You may select your own category. We recommend as follows:

- **Professional**: An artist who sells artwork as a source of income and competes on a regular basis.
- **Intermediate**: An artist who has competed in Paint the Town in prior years and other plein air competitions.
- Novice: An artist who has never participated in a plein air competition prior to Paint the Town 2023.

LOCATIONS

- All artworks to be considered in the competition <u>must be completed on site</u> during the dates of the event, May 9 May 13, 2023.
- Location must be within the City limits of Alpharetta.
- There will be limited access to some special locations offered each day at Alpharetta Arts Center (first come first served.)
- The Quick Draw competition *suggested* locations are City Center, Brooke Street Park, Avalon and Alpha Loop on May 12, between 4:30-6:30 PM. Artists will deliver one Quick Draw/Paint entry on their own easel to the Town Green at City Center 7:30 PM for judging.
- Alpharetta Arts Center is located at 238 Canton Street, Alpharetta, GA 30009

SALES: Artists will be allowed and encouraged to exhibit their work as available for sale, please affix entry form to the back of your work submitted for exhibition and sale. Arts Alpharetta will facilitate sales during the exhibition and at the Wet Paint Tent Sale. All sales transactions will be conducted by Arts Alpharetta. Arts Alpharetta will collect and remit sales tax in accordance with Georgia tax laws. Artists will be given a tax form to complete and retain for their records regarding sales tax. Arts Alpharetta will retain a 30% commission on all sales. Artists may indicate that a piece is not for sale (NFS). Proceeds from the event will fund two initiatives: Takeout Art: which supplies *free* art kits for children in our community and the Public Art Fund: supporting the lease of public art in partnership with the City of Alpharetta. The City of Alpharetta does not permit "busking" or sales by individuals participating on location during the event.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What exactly is a plein air event? Arts Alpharetta is happy to host a *plein air* (open air) painting event for artists that will occur in the city of Alpharetta, in partnership within partnership with the City of Alpharetta and the Alpharetta Convention and Visitors Bureau

Does everyone who registers 'get in'? Artists 18 years and over are invited to participate.

Where can I stay if coming from out of town? The Alpharetta Convention and Visitors Bureau will be securing blocks of hotel rooms at a discounted rate soon. Included in that message will be a link to see all hotels in Alpharetta for artist's consideration.

Can I check in early? No. Check-in is at 8 AM on Tuesday the 9th. There will be someone to stamp surfaces every day at the Alpharetta Art Center.

Can I start a painting early and finish it at the event? No. This is a juried exhibition. All surfaces must be stamped on the back at registration and have to be completed during the dates of the event (May 9 - 13). Yes, we know your paintings will be wet at the judging and expect that.

How many paintings may I submit for the competitions?

- Up to four (4) pieces for exhibition (2 for the Juror and 2 back-up pieces)
- One (1) piece for Quick Draw/Paint for Juror (and display at the exhibition.)
- Pieces for the Wet Paint Tent Sale (no larger than 7" in any direction), limit of 10.
- All paintings must have been *started and finished* during Paint the Town, May 9-13, 2023.

Is there a size limit to paintings? Yes, artworks for the gallery exhibition for the 5-day event and Quick Draw/Paint competition are to be no larger than 40" in any direction (including frame.) Small works are to be no larger than 7" in any in any direction.

Are gallery wrapped canvases allowed? Yes, gallery wrapped canvases (2" deep) are allowed but must be wired for hanging. We ask that artists paint/prepare the edges with black or medium gray acrylic paint to keep paint from marring gallery walls. Traditional stretched canvases (less than 1" deep) and panels are allowed but must be framed and ready to hang for the exhibition. Unlike last year, we will NOT have a framer located on site. Artists need to plan on how works will be installed.

Can I paint somewhere that is not on the map? It is recommended to select a site from the map because we have permission to use those locations for our artists. If an artist has a spot which is either public, or they have otherwise secured the necessary permission to be there and it is within the Alpharetta City limits, you may paint there. Artists may seek their own locations as long as they paint within the city limits of Alpharetta.

Maps will be provided showing: 1. Alpharetta City Limits, 2. Pre-approved locations, 3. Recommended locations for painting during the Quick Draw/Paint competition.

Do we have to stay the whole time? Can we arrive late? Registration begins on Tuesday, May 9th at 8 AM. You may work at your leisure until the competition pieces are due, Friday, May 12. Judging will take place on Saturday. Artists may arrive late but need to alert Nancy Murphy at nancyjmurphy16@gmail.com of their arrival date to accommodate late registration.

Will anything be provided, like chairs or small tables, etc.? Or do we bring everything that we would need? Artists should bring all the supplies that they would need to paint outdoors. Please be a good guest, do not leave any trash behind and do not dispose of solvents in public trash cans or onto the ground.

What is the rain plan? If there will be a rain date, do you have that yet? Presently the event will be held rain or shine, depending on the severity of the forecast.

Are children permitted to accompany the artist? Families are welcome at the reception. Paint the Town is designed for adult artists; there are no activities planned for children at this event.
