### IMPORTANT ITEMS TO NOTE:

- All artworks to be considered in the competition must be completed on location sites during the dates of the event, May 17 - May 21, 2022.
  - Painting surfaces must be stamped on the back by officials at the Alpharetta Arts Center.
  - Painting location must be within the city limits of Alpharetta.
  - There will be limited access to some special locations offered each day at Alpharetta Arts Center (*first come first served*).
  - The map includes spaces where artists have permission to paint on site. Artists should not paint on private property without permission.
- ★ **Alpharetta Arts Center** is located at 238 Canton Street. This is the event "hub" where artists register and stamp art pieces.
